Our Year 11 and Year 8 Debating teams had one of their best seasons. Year 8 finished in the top 4 and Year 11 are the State Champions!



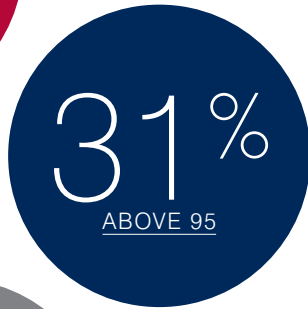

A leader in girls' education for more than 128 years, Korowa is renowned for its academic excellence. Our VCE results placed us among the top ten Non-Government schools in Victoria.



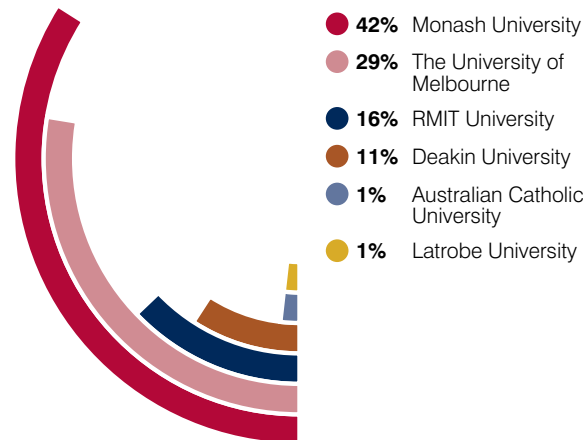

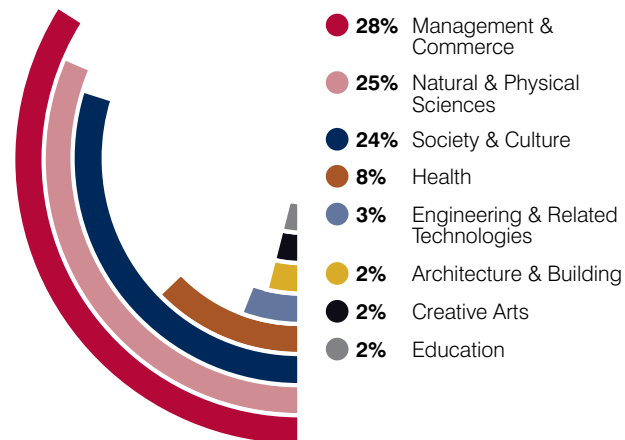

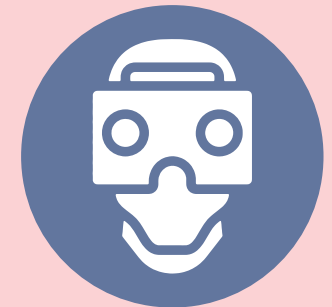


Five students shortlisted
