



International Student Advocate Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this Policy is to ensure that International students enrolled at Korowa have an independent adult support person who resides in Australia for the duration of their enrolment at Korowa. This person is the Student Advocate.

Scope

This Policy applies to all International Students enrolled at Korowa.

Korowa's Policy

International Students enrolled at the School may reside with:

1. A parent on a Guardianship Visa; or
2. A Department of Immigration and Boarder Protection approved relative; or
3. A Korowa approved Homestay Family (in accordance with the requirements of our Homestay policy)

Where a student is not residing with a parent on a guardianship visa or a relative approved by the Department of Immigration and Boarder Protection they are required to have a Student Advocate in Australia for the duration of their enrolment.

The Student Advocate must be arranged through ISA or a Korowa approved provider.

ISA is an independent student care and support service located in Australia. The role of the Student Advocate is that of an independent third party to advocate in the best interests of the student. They will work with the School and the parents to provide independent support and advice to the students and the parents (as required). The Student Advocate is not a legal guardian of the student.

The appointment of a Student Advocate for the student must be approved by Korowa.

Parent/Guardian Responsibility

Parents/guardians are required to arrange approved support services for their daughters. All costs associated with arranging an approved Student Advocate must be covered by the students' parents/guardian.

Approved Student Advocates must be located in Melbourne, Victoria.

The Student Advocate arrangements must be in place before a student commences at Korowa.

Korowa's Responsibility

Upon confirmation of:

1. Approved Student Advocate arrangements; and
2. Approved homestay arrangements (see Homestay Policy); and
3. Confirmation of ELICOS enrolment (if required)

Korowa will issue an Electronic Confirmation of Enrolment to the Agent in order to finalise the student visa application.
